Video Capture Module



Continuous Video loops work fine until you want to find an event that happened last week, or last month.

Someone is faced with hours of screening tapes, that may have been since recycled and erased in the meantime.

Enter the SafeHouse Video Capture System, which seamlessly integrates with the SafeHouse Entry Controller Module.

The output of up to four cameras can be multiplexed into a single digital image, complete with a

time-date stamp which is then indexed to the guest entry and saved. Simply select the entry from the traffic files, click a button, and you're looking at the entry event. The screen can also be printed.

Multi-Image Four-camera support means you can capture views of the front and back of the car, the driver's face, and even his photo ID. There is no question that you can positively identify the individual and his vehicle, should the need arise.

An Excellent Back-up Device When used in conjunction with tape, the Entry Module's time-date stamp allows you to quickly locate the event and view the entire entry in real time. Having a picture of the vehicle and it's license plate also provides a fail-safe to inadvertent typographical errors.

Centralized Storage Multi-gated communities operating on fiber may choose to store the captured images from each entry point on a centralized machine. SafeHouse provides support for large disk arrays which are capable of storing more than one million four-camera images.
